

THIS FORM IS AFFECTED BY THE PRIVACY ACT OF 1974
TURKISH TRAFFIC LAW 2918, SECTION 28

An individual who owns a vehicle or rubber tired tractor or motorcycle or moped is not permitted to use it in traffic, unless it has been registered his/her local Traffic Bureau of his place of business or residence.

Interpretation: A vehicle is not considered to be registered until as set of metal license plates have been issued to the registered owner, plates have been affixed to the vehicle and a current registration and emissions certificate has been obtained.

NOTE: Temporary license plates (paper plates) are issued with the intended purpose of allowing US forces personnel a method of legally transporting their privately owned vehicle from the Delta office to their place of residence while the registration process is being completed. Personnel operating a vehicle with temporary plates must take their vehicle directly to their designated place of storage on base as these are temporary plates, which indicate the vehicle is not fully registered. Temporary plates are valid for two days. The day the plate is issued is the first day and the next day is the second. If a person obtains a set of temporary plates on the last duty day of the week, the plates will expire the next calendar day, NOT the next duty day.

Failure to comply with proper licensing procedures will result in the vehicle operator being issued a DD Form 1408/Traffic Citation for failure to register a Motor Vehicle.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

THE PERSON APPLYING FOR REGISTRATION MUST BE THE INDIVIDUAL WHOSE NAME WILL APPEAR ON THE BEYANNAME (Turkish Customs Form); AND WHO HAS APPLIED FOR THE TAX EXEMPTION AND TURKISH INSURANCE.

IAW 39 ABW/CC ANTITERRORISM/FORCE PROTECTION (AT/FP) DIRECTIVES: ALL DD FORM 2220's (VEHICLE DECALS) FROM PREVIOUS DUTY STATIONS WILL BE REMOVED. ANY DECALS, STICKERS, WINDOW CLINGS AND MAGNETIC DECALS ASSOCIATING YOUR VEHICLE AS FROM THE UNITED STATES SHOULD ALSO BE REMOVED.

FAILURE TO REGISTER YOUR VEHICLE WITHIN 90 DAYS OF THE DATE LISTED ON YOUR AUTO BEYANNAME PAPERWORK WILL RESULT IN A FINE BY THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES. IF YOUR VEHICLE FAILS INSPECTION YOU MUST IMMEDIATELY CORRECT THE DISCREPANCY AND GET IT REINSPECTED BEFORE THE 30-DAY LIMIT HAS EXPIRED.

ENSURE YOU DO NOT SAVE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION ON THE PUBLIC DRIVE.

VEHICLE INSPECTION CRITERIA

1. **VEHICLE SURFACE:** Must be clean and free of dirt and rust. The vehicle color must match the description on the vehicle registration cards and the Auto-Beyanname.
2. **WINDOWS:** Must be able to withstand shock and vibrations. Windows must be CLEAR with (NO TINT) unless from factory and free of cracks. Windows must be easily opened and closed. Please remove any signs, stickers or advertisements prior to your inspection.
3. **WIPERS:** Must be fully operational and able to remove rain, snow and dust from windows. There must be at least one wiper in front of the driver side windshield.
4. **HEADLIGHTS:** Both high and low beams must be symmetrical, properly adjusted and operational.
5. **BRAKE LIGHTS:** All brake lights must be operational.
6. **BRAKES:** Must be in good working condition and able to stop at short distances while traveling at an average speed. Both vehicle brakes must be operational and engage when used.
7. **LICENSE PLATE LAMP:** Must be visible from at least 20 meters.
8. **LICENSE PLATES:** Must be affixed firmly to the vehicle. The distance from the bottom edge of the plate and the road must be between 20-75 cm for the front and 30-125 cm for the rear. The bottom portion of the plates must be lower than the bumper and readable. For imported cars, modified plate brackets may be used to ensure a proper fit. The modified plates must be sealed by the official.
9. **TIRE/RIMS:** Your current tires and rims must be in good/serviceable condition and the original sizes from the manufacturer. Aftermarket rims and tires are not allowed.
10. **MUFFLERS:** Must not produce excessive noise and not be longer than the vehicle itself. The muffler must point directly towards the rear of the vehicle and not towards the ground. It also must be free of leaks and not produce fumes inside the vehicle.
11. **ENGINE BLOCK:** Should not be excessively dirty or full of debris. You engine number should be legible and also know the locations of your VIN and engine number.
12. **OTHER REQUIRED ITEMS:** You are required to have a First Aid Kit. The contents of the kit must include the following- large bandage, iodine, absorbent gas pack, alcohol, cotton, hydrogen peroxide, bandages, fire extinguisher, tow rope, road chalks, triangular reflector X2, and a body bag. You must also have a jack and lug wrench available. If you own a bus, truck or jeep you are required to have mud flaps attached.
13. **DOCUMENT CONTROL:** Please ensure you have all required documents together such as Black Registration Book, Beyanname and current insurance.

NOTICE: IF YOU FAIL YOUR POV INSPECTION YOU MUST IMMEDIATELY CORRECT THE FAILED DISCREPANCY AND GET IT RE-INSPECTED WITHIN YOUR 30 DAY LIMIT OR FACE PAYING A RE-INSPECTION FEE AND 5% SURCHARGE. SAFETY INSPECTION AND EMISSIONS TESTS MUST BE CONDUCTED EVERY TWO YEARS FOR 4 DOOR SEDANS AND ANNUALLY FOR TRUCKS OR JEEPS. YOU'RE POV REGISTRATION IS VALID AS LONG AS YOU REMAIN IN THE COUNTRY WITH THE SAME VEHICLE.
