## **CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT JUSTIN G. STOLTZFUS**

Chief Master Sergeant Justin G. Stoltzfus serves as the Command Chief Master Sergeant, 39th Air Base Wing, Incirlik Air Base, Turkey. As the command chief, he serves as the principal enlisted leader to the wing commander on all matters of readiness, training, utilization, health, welfare, moral, and professional development for approximately 3,500 U.S. military, civilian and contractor personnel assigned to Incirlik and five geographically separated units in Turkey. Additionally, Chief Stoltzfus advises the commander for Base Operations Support Integration (BOS-I) activities for Turkey-based joint and combined combat forces conducting operations in the region.



Chief Stoltzfus entered the Air Force in December 1997. He graduated from the Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning, Refrigeration (HVAC/R) maintenance course at Sheppard Air Force Base, Texas, in August 1998. Since then, he has held a variety of leadership positions at the squadron and group levels, including First Sergeant duty from March 2014 through November 2017.
