COMPENSATION

Military Leaders Economic Security Toolkit on Military OneSource regularly updated with financial support information.



UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS

Furloughed employees are eligible to apply. Excepted employees (*working full-time*) are not eligible. File with state unemployment office (*based on last duty station*). If employees receive retroactive pay, they are required to pay unemployment benefits back. See OPM guidance & U.S. Dept of Labor for resources.



FOOD INSECURITY

First Sergeants & Readiness Centers assist with referrals to:

- USDA Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program
- Federal Subsistence Program Supplemental Allowance
- Air Force Aid Society grants/loans

Basic Needs Allowance (BNA) support is available for families with incomes below 200% of the federal poverty line.



TRICARE

TRICARE continues during shutdown. Civilian providers are unaffected. Military hospitals/clinics remain open.



COMMISSARIES

Check your local commissary status online. Some non-appropriated fund services may continue.
